

CONSTITUTIONAL RULES

TITLE

This organization shall be called the ANTIQUE MOTORCYCLE CLUB OF MANITOBA, and hereinafter shall be referred to as the A. M. C. M.

PUBLICATION

The newsletter's official name by vote is "Rust in Pieces".

This newsletter shall be used to keep any out-of-town or any other absent member up to date with the activities of the club each month.

OBJECTS OR PURPOSE

The objects of this club shall be:

To encourage the ownership, use, preservation, restoration and maintenance of classic and antique motorcycles.

To organize, cause to be organized or assist in the organization of rallies, sporting events and other events as may be in the interest of this club.

To actively foster the preservation of all records- data, objecys, and miscellaneous items pertaining in any way to the history of antique motorcycles and similar associated matters.

To provide through the (its) Officers and organization such services as may be required by members to further the objects of the Club.

To publish a newsletter to be called "Rust in Pieces", a publication which shall report upon the activities of the Club.

ROSTER

As members dues are paid, each member shall fill out a roster form for each year. Any member wishing to list his/her motorcycle may do so on his/her roster sheet.

AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended by a 75% vote of the members present at any regular meeting provided that written notice of the proposed amendments have been noted in the previous A. M. C. M. newsletter, but also must be made up of 15 members in good standing.

GOVERNMENT

The government of this club shall consist of an executive of 3 members, being the President, Past-President and Secretary-Treasurer.

The executive shall have control and management of the property and club- subject to the will of the membership.

Funds of the club shall be withdrawn by signature of the treasurer and/or president.

Vacancies in the executive or any office shall be filled by a vote of the club; such persons appointed to serve for the duration of the term of the individual being replaced or until the next regular election.

MEMBERSHIPS

Membership of the club shall be available to any person who owns or has owned a motorcycle or any person interested in the aims and objects of the Club.

The annual dues shall be \$10.00 (ten dollars) which includes all A. M. C. M. benefits.

The dues are payable as of February meeting. As of the August meeting, dues for the remainder of the year will be \$5.00 (five dollars). After November, the \$10.00 payable is for the next year's dues.

ELECTIONS

At the annual election there shall be elected a President and Secretary-Treasurer. also an appointed committee consisting of a Librarian, Editor, Public Manager, and Typist.

Voting for this committee will be carried out by the members present at the year-end December meeting.

The executive will take office as of January of the next year and will hold that office for a period of one year.

DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS

The President- Chief executive shall supervise the club's affairs and activities.

The Secretary-Treasurer- shall give notice of all regular meetings and keep permanent records of the minutes of such meetings and all other documents and records that relate to club activities.

-shall collect dues payable and make sure roster forms are filled out at that time, keep books of the club, disburse funds at the direction of the executive and report at the monthly meetings the financial condition of the club.

- the Treasurer shall have the books audited at the end of the fiscal year, month of December.

The Past-President - shall take the place of the present President if absent from any monthly meeting., as well as be responsible for recruiting nominees for the upcoming executive.

APPOINTED COMMITTEE

The Librarian- shall be responsible for the purchase of new books, the cataloging procedure; is also responsible for monthly raffle to raise funds for new books; responsible

for bringing books to meetings.

The Editor- shall be responsible for printing the A. M. C. M. newsletter each month and the yearly roster and any other printed matter.

The Public Manager- shall look after promoting and advertising in the club's interest. Also responsible for poster and art work.

The Typist- shall type all information requested and required in the interest of the club.

ASSOCIATED MEMBERSHIPS

Any spouse is automatically included in the club, provided his/her partner holds a membership.

The spouse has all rights that paying members have, permits them to share all club activities except that he or she cannot vote, cannot hold elected position on executive committee; but can be elected for any appointed position.
