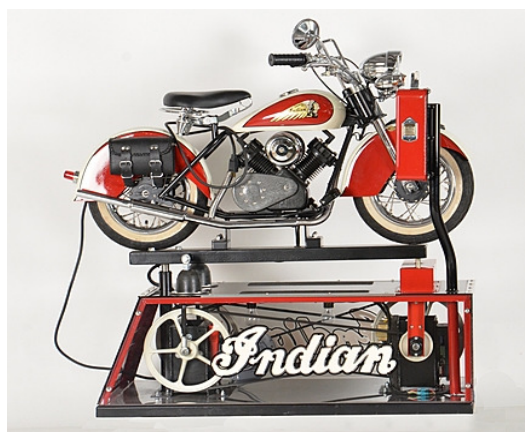

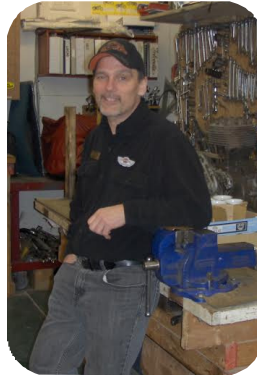

NOT A MOVIE NIGHT at JOHN THOMPSON'S

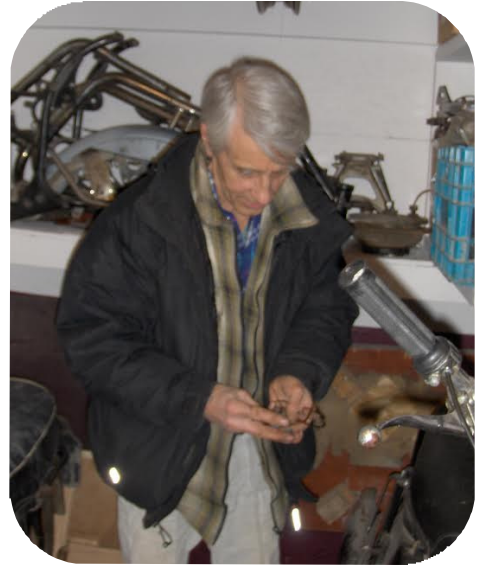

AMA Hall of Famer Dick Klamfoth and his wife lose home in fire

Family establishes online donation page to help Klamfoths get back on their feet



During the early morning of Saturday, Dec. 20, AMA Hall of Famer Richard (Dick) Klamfoth and his wife Beverly (Bev) lost their Thornville, Ohio, home as a result of a fire. Not only was the home a complete loss, the fire also took the lives of their animals and destroyed their vehicles and barn.

Dick and Bev were transported to Licking Memorial Hospital, where Dick was released later that day and Bev was transferred to OSU for smoke inhalation. Both are now staying with family until they get back on their feet.

Dick is a three-time Daytona 200 winner and was named AMA's Most Popular Rider in 1961. In total, he achieved 12 AMA national wins and one international win. Later, in 1998, he was inducted into the [AMA Motorcycle Museum Hall of Fame](#). He also owned a Honda dealership and the Honda Hills motocross facility in Ohio during the '70s. In recent years, he worked with the City of Daytona to place a [Daytona 200 monument](#) to honor those who raced on the beach. He continues to support the sport and actively participates in Daytona Bike Week.

BOBBY HILL



Member of the famed "Indian Wrecking Crew".
Won the inaugural race of the first AMA Grand National Championship series.

Bobby Hill earned the title of AMA National Champion in 1951 and 1952 by virtue of his victories on the Springfield Mile. Hill won a total of 12 AMA nationals during his professional racing career spanning the years 1947 to 1959. Hill was always known as one of the most friendly riders of his era and was voted the AMA's Most Popular Rider in 1951.

INDIAN LEGEND BUTCH BAER



A biography of Butch Baer, known to be a motorcycle builder and racing legend, is presented. He was born in 1927 to the Indian clan headed by Frank Paul "Fritzie" Baer with renown in New England motorcycling. He assembled his first motorcycle at age 11, won the 80" Novice Hill Climb at age 14 and placed fourth in the Daytona 100-miler at age 19. It discusses his foray into publishing, such as "My Dream and How I Did It" which details his rebuild for the 101 Scout motorcycle called Miss Bitzy.

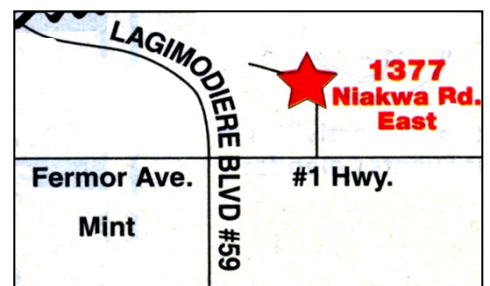

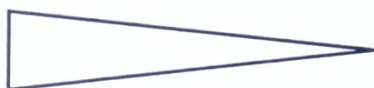

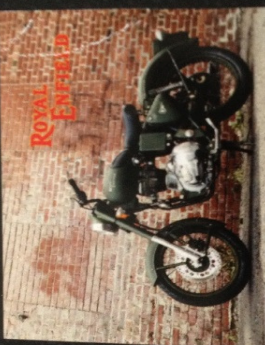
