Constitution and Bylaws-

Following is the constitution. We have discussed and voted on the parts from TITLE through to AMENDMENTS at our January 22nd meeting. The remainder must be discussed and voted on lat the next meeting or two. Read them over and if there are any changes or additions you would like to make, bring them up at the meeting.

CONSTITUTION

TITLE

This organization shall be called the "ANTIQUE MOTORCYCLE CLUB OF MANITOBA", and hereinafter referred to as the "A.M.C.M."

OBJECT OR PURPOSE

The objectives of this club shall be;

- -To encourage the ownership, use, preservation, restoration, and maintenance of classic and antique motorcycles.
- -To organize, cause to be organized or assist in the organization of rallies, sporting events and other events as may be in the interest of this club.
- -To actively foster the preservation of all records--data, objects, and miscellaneous items pertaining in any way to the history of antique motor-cycles and similar associated matters.
- -To provide through its officers and organization such services as may be required by its members to further the objectives of the club.
- -To publish a newsletter tobe called "Rust 'n' Pieces" which shall report upon the activities of the club.

PUBLICATION-

The newsletter's official name shall be "Rust 'n' Pieces".

This newsletter shall be used to keep out-of-town or absent members up to date with the activities of the club.

This newsletter shall be published once a month, and sent to each paid up member.

ROSTER

As members dues are paid, he/she shall fill out a roster form for each year. Any member wishing to listhis/her motorcycles may do so an his/her roster form.

AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended by a 75% vote of the members present at any regular meeting provided that written notice of the proposed amendments have been noted in the previous A.M.C.M. Newsletter. There must be 15 members in good standing present at a meeting where amendments are voted on.

GOVERNMENT

The government of this club shall consist of an executive of ____ members.

The executive shall have control and management of the property and club-subject to the will of the membership.

Funds of the club shall be withdrawn by the signature of the treasurer and/or president.

Vacancies in the executive or any office shall be filled by a vote of the executive; such persons appointed to serve for the duration of the term of the individual being replaced, or until the next regular election.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the club shall be available to any person who owns or has owned motorcycle or any person interested in the aims and objectives of the club.

The annual dues shall be \$10.00(ten dollars), which includes the A.M.C.M. Newslettereach month.

The dues are payable as of the February meeting. As of the August meeting dues for the remainder of the year will be \$5.00(five dollars). After November, the \$10.00 payable are for the next year's dues.

ELECTIONS

At the annual election there shall be elected a President, Past President, Secretary-Treasurer, Librarian, Editor, and also an appointed committee, consisting of a Mublicity Manager and Typist.

The members who fill these positions will form the executive committee.

Voting for this committee will be carried out by the members present

at the year end December Meeting.

The executive will take office as of January of the next year and will hold that office for a period of one year.

DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS

The President -- Chief executive shall supervise the clubs affairs and activities.

The <u>Secretary-Treasurer</u> -- shall give notice of all regular meetings and keep permanant records of the minutes of such meetings and all other documents and records that relate to club activities.

shall collect dues payable and make sure roster forms are filled out at that time, keep books of the club, disburse funds at the direction of the executive and report at the monthly meetings the financial condition of the club.

shall have the books audited at the end of the fiscal year, month of December.

The <u>Past President</u>--shall take the place of present President if absent from any monthly meeting.

The <u>Librarian</u>--shall be responsible for the purchase of new books, the cataloging procedure, is also responsible for monthly raffle to raise funds for new books, is responsible for bringing books to meetings.

The Editor -- shall be responsible for printing the A.M.C.M. Newsletter each monthand the yearly roster and any other printed matter.

Appointed Committee

Publicity Manager -- shall look after promoting and advertising in the clubs interest. Poster and art work.

Typist--shall type all information requested and required in the interest of the club.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Any spouse is automatically included in the club, provided his or her partner holds a membership.

The spouse has all rights that paying members have, permits them to share all club activities except that he or she cannot vote, cannot hold elected position on executive committee; but can be elected for any appointed position.
