A motion to adjourn was made by Ray Houde at 8:25 p.m. Seconded by Joanne Butcher. Carried

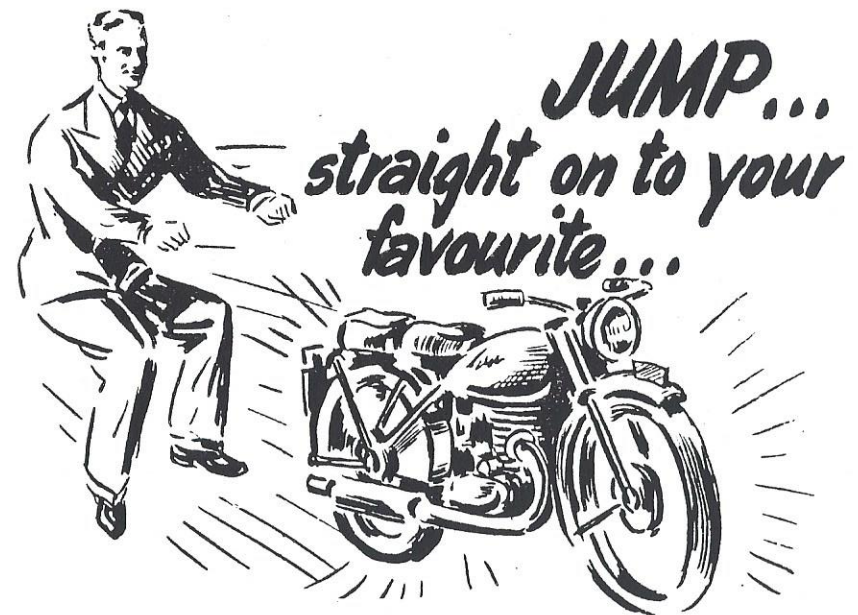
