would get together to review a budget with a view to

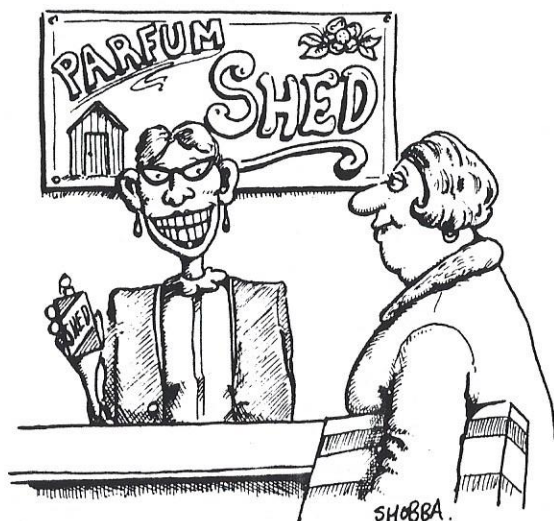

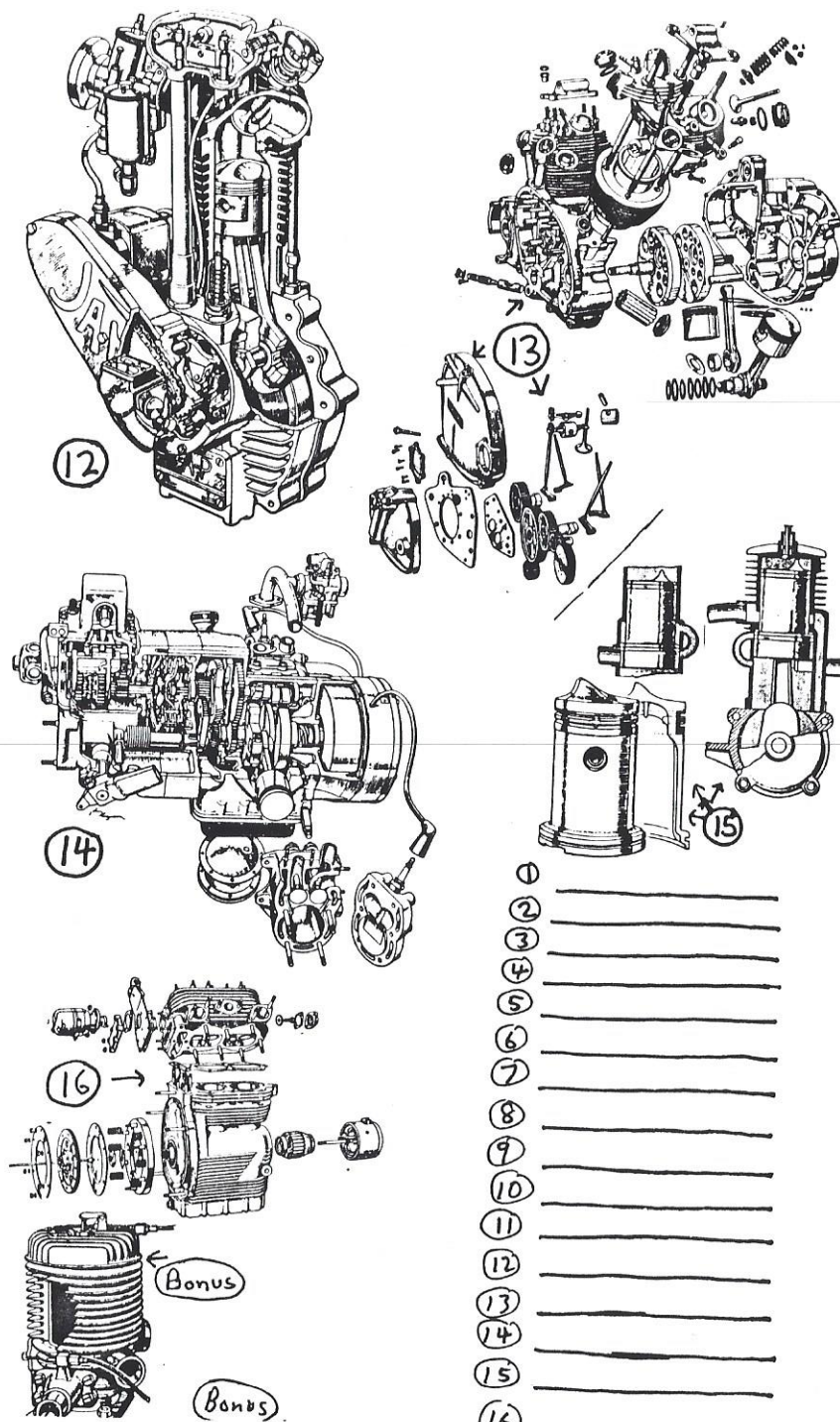


DAVENPORT, IOWA MEET
