Guidelines for Saturday's Show 'n' Shine

- **Note:** the "Bentley" award for "Best in Show" is reserved for **AMCM** or **CVMG** members only.
- There is a "People's Choice" class, open to voting by show' n' shine entrants and the general public
- Show classes will be marked, please line your bikes in the appropriate class, noting that the Rally Show 'n' Shine Coordinator has final call in which class bikes are placed
- Classes are as follows with a trophy for **1st** place:
 - bikes must be 1989 model year or older for the five vintage classes:
American, European, British, Asian, Three Wheels
 - **Non-Antique** (modern) 1990 model year to present.
- "**Year of the BSA**" entrants receive 1 token prize for their 1989 model yr. and older BSA entries, and, these bikes can be entered in the Show 'n' Shine at the Owner's discretion and subject to the same guidelines as all other entries.
