- ▶ Many comments – thank-you!

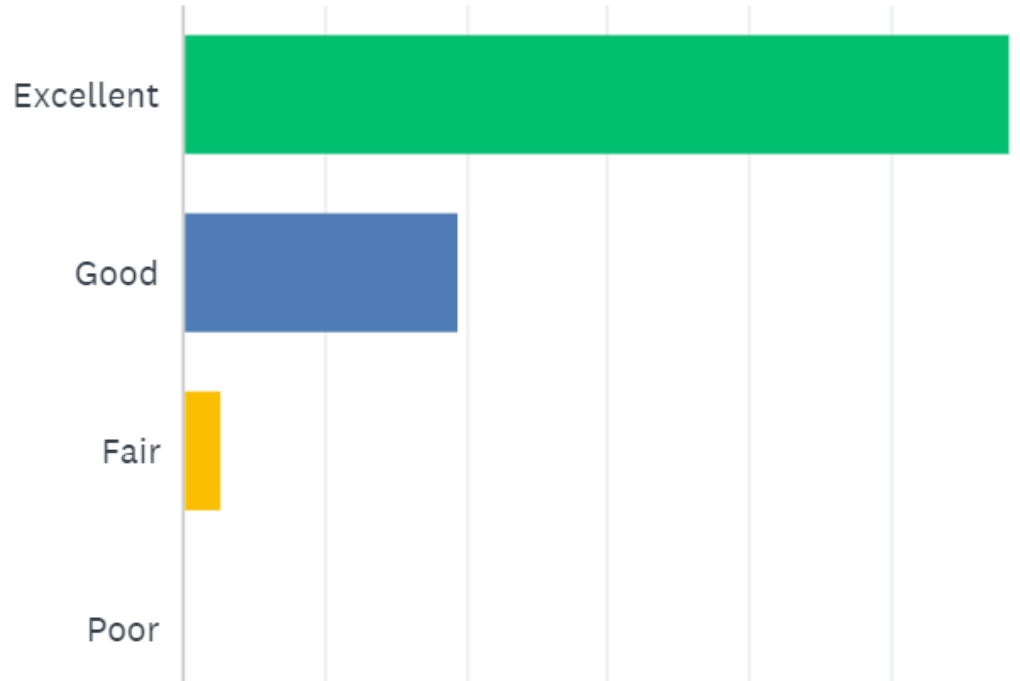
How would you rate the facilities for camping at Cartier Park?



Comments:

- Would be nice to have more 30-amp sites
- Noisy with highway traffic

Comments:

- Many positive comments around the facility, including “has a family feel”, and good to have the hall for us for the whole weekend
- Sound echoed a lot
- Likes that overhead doors could be opened/closed
- Would like AC
- Looking forward to showers/bathrooms being finished in that facility

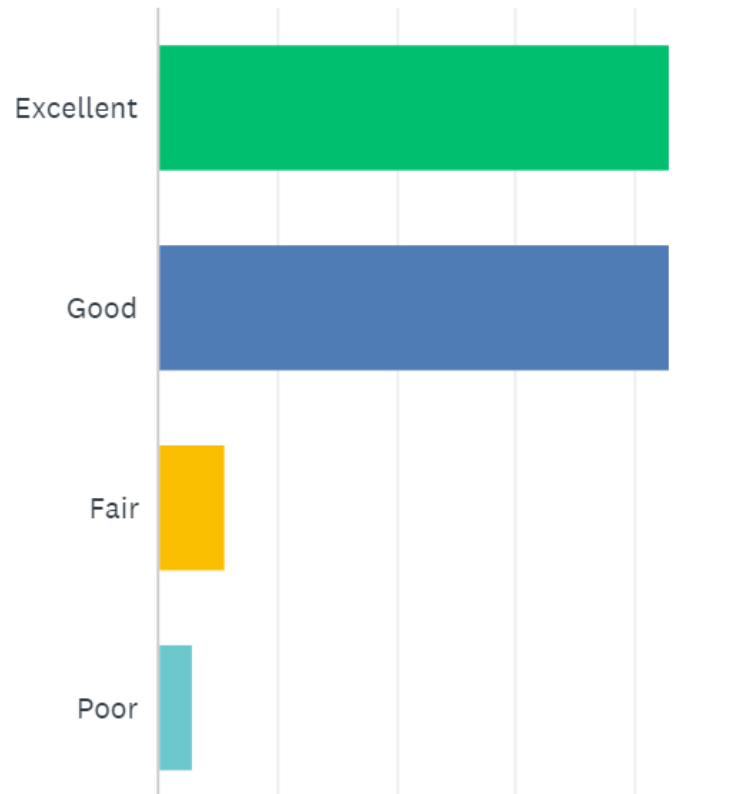
How would you rate the Ste. Agathe park used for the Show n Shine?

- Many comments that Show n Shine should be held at the campground parking lot

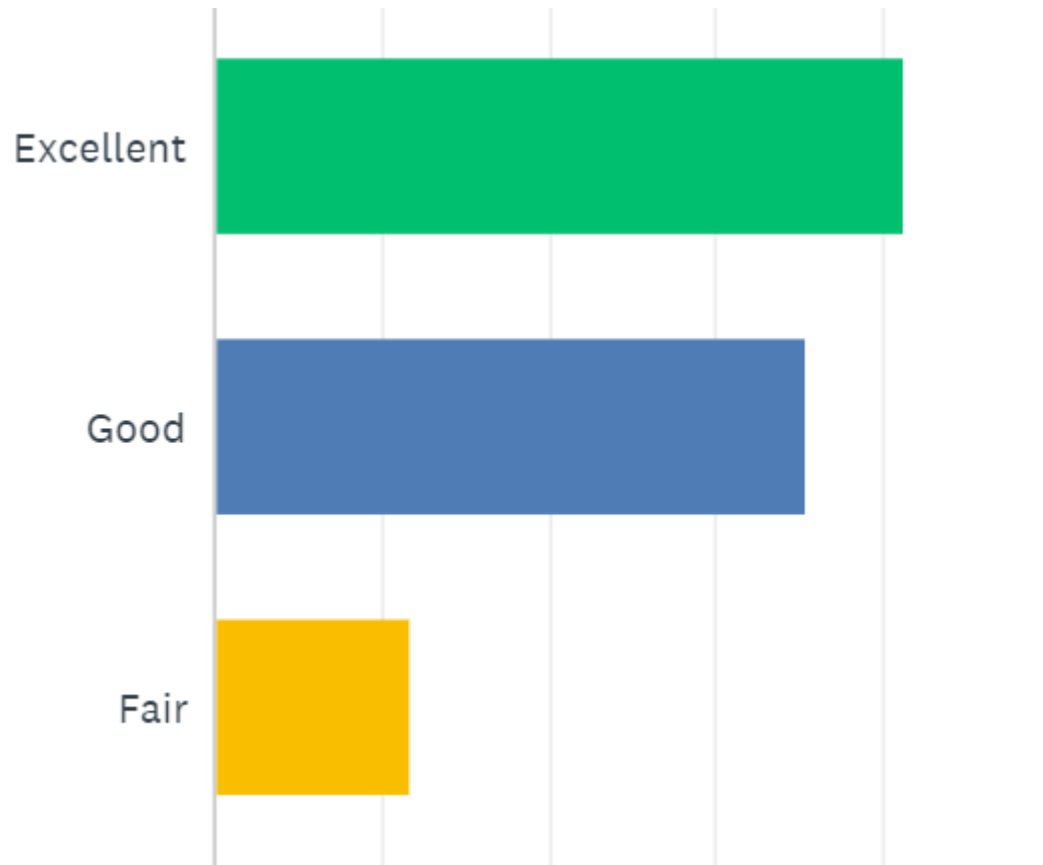
How would you rate the food service for this year's Rally?



Comments:

- The O'Kane's chili on Friday night was a HIT!!!
- Appreciation for the amount of bacon at breakfast, but concerns about some plastic in the eggs (2 comments)
- Concerns around whether the smoked chicken on Saturday was properly cooked
- Continental breakfast on Sunday could have been better – not enough muffins
- Comments around whether the club should manage the food in-house to reduce costs

Comments:

- Many comments on the fun of the games and thanks to the Charletons for this
- Announce the games with a bull horn to get more attendees
- Suggestion of "sharing" smaller and/or enduro-type bikes to get more people to try

What would you change about the Rally itself?

- ▶ Better signage at the Park to indicate it was closed to other campers for the weekend
- ▶ Maybe change it to a one or two day event
- ▶ Schedule trivia for Friday night so it's in the program
- ▶ Schedule a start time for the bonfire
- ▶ Not a good parade without spectators (4 comments on parade, questioning value of this event)
- ▶ Show n Shine in the campground parking lot or at the Flying J (4 comments like this)
- ▶ Tenting closer to the dining hall would be nice
- ▶ How about a swap meet or a bike corral of available units

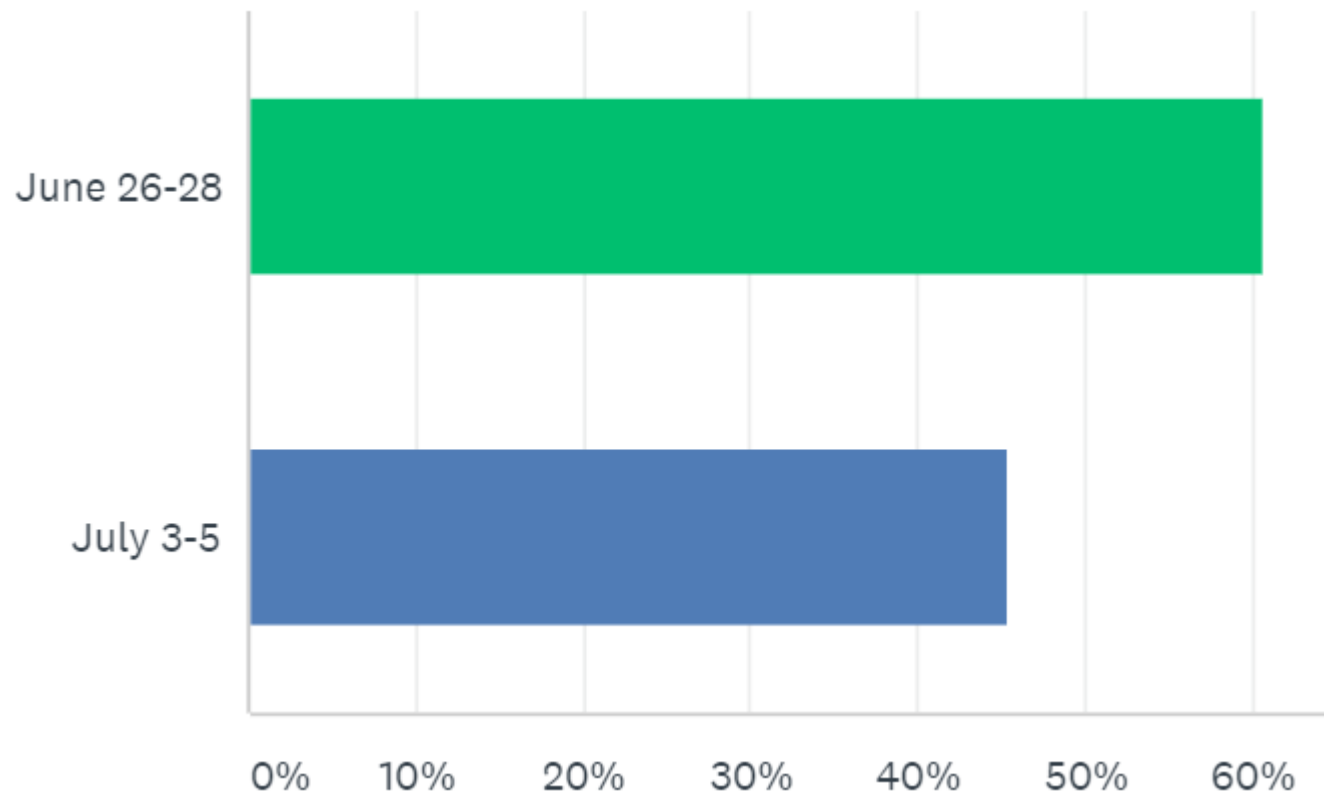
What would you change about the Rally itself?

- ▶ Don't charge extra for tenting/unserviced sites
- ▶ Hold it later in the year, perhaps September
- ▶ Keep the price down and more people will attend. Make a bigger price difference for early registration. Talk up the rally during meetings and shame members to register. Tell them it's their DUTY to go to our rally. Lots of members told me that they had simply forgotten about the rally!
- ▶ Let's have an antique bike on t-shirts, maybe the marque of the year. Something more suited to the kind of club this is.
- ▶ More local advertising; we need more weekend participants from our own club, but it would also be nice to see a larger turnout for the Show 'n Shine
- ▶ Suggest an afternoon or early evening organized ride each day: 1.5-2 hrs long?

- ▶ Many positive results around how fun the event is!
- ▶ Keep 2020 at Ste. Agathe
- ▶ Need more volunteers – keep seeing the same folks doing the bulk of the work
