August 3rd & 4th - Biggar British Bike Rally in Biggar, Saskatchewan. This rally is hosted at the farm of John and Shirley Bennett, which is located eight miles south of Biggar on Highway No. 4. Watch for the sign, turn east for about two miles of gravel and a $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north and you are there. The rally starts around noon on Saturday and after registration, there will be a Poker Run followed by a barbeque. Sunday morning starts off with a pancake breakfast and there will be awards for bikes. Registration fee is \$12.00 and meals \$5.00 each (\$2.50 for children). You can also pre-register by sending a cheque for \$30.00 made payable to the Biggar British Bike Rally. If you wish to camp at the Rally, there will be space on the farm Saturday night.

PHOTO RUN

Provide a photograph of your antique motorcycle and the location for one point per location. Highest point total is ten points. The ten locations are:

Gimli, Selkirk, Breezy Point, Portage la Prairie, Grand Beach, Lower Fort Garry, Steinbach, St. Adolphe, Morris & Stonewall.

There will be two classes; Classic, being 1956 to 1976 bikes and Vintage, being pre-1956 bikes.

MOST ACTIVE MEMBER

Points will be given for attending Club events and meetings and an award will be given to the top finisher. The point system is as follows:

One point for attending events;

Two points for attending event on a motorcycle;

Three points for attending event on a classic motorcycle (1956-1976);

Four points for attending event on a vintage motorcycle (pre-1956);

Points for the Thursday and Sunday runs may only be collected once a month for each run (for example: four points for Thursdays and four points for Sundays for a maximum total of eight points per month for attending these runs on a vintage motorcycle). Bonus points will be awarded for finishing the Photo Run with five points on a classic and seven points on a vintage motorcycle. Once a month points may be collected for out-of-province events and a picture is required for verification. Again, five points will be awarded for the Photo Run with a classic bike and seven for a vintage.
