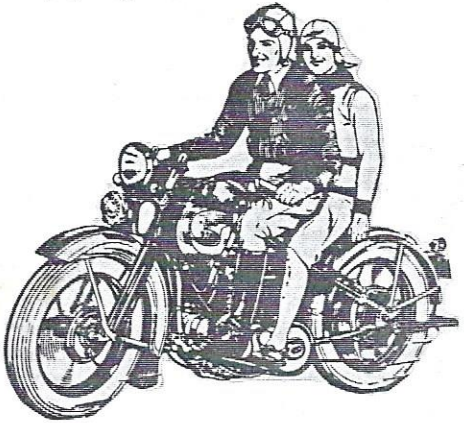

Tech Tidbit

Polyester resins come in two types, "air dry" and "non-air dry".
The non-air dry type is used in body putty, and that is the reason it remains slightly tacky on the surface after it sets up. That is also the reason it clogs up sandpaper when you try to sand it. However, it also means that a second layer will bond securely to it. It will set up hard and non-sticky on the inside surface facing a mould, such as I use for the battery boxes.
The air dry (usually the liquid or marine type) contains a wax that floats to the surface and causes it to cure non sticky. The wax can cause non-sticking of a second layer, so be careful. In a mould however, it will cure sticky and cause all kinds of problems. Non-air dry liquid resins are available, but from specialty suppliers, possibly the craft shops, sold as "Casting Resin".
Epoxy types are entirely different, harder and more brittle, and usually with a brownish tint. It is usually mixed 1 to 1, and MUST be mixed thoroughly, for the recommended time (usually 2- 5 minutes) or it will NOT harden - I learned that the hard way!
