A.M.C.M. Minutes of April 27, 1998 meeting

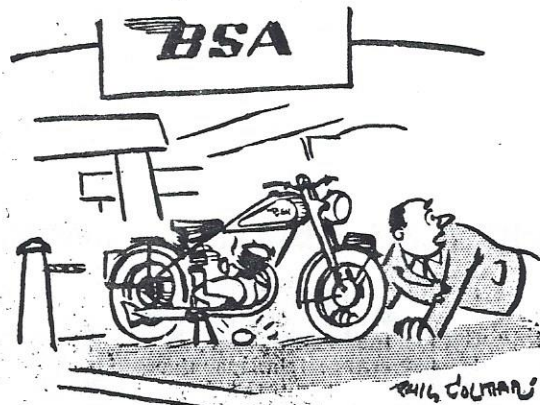
