MAAC Report

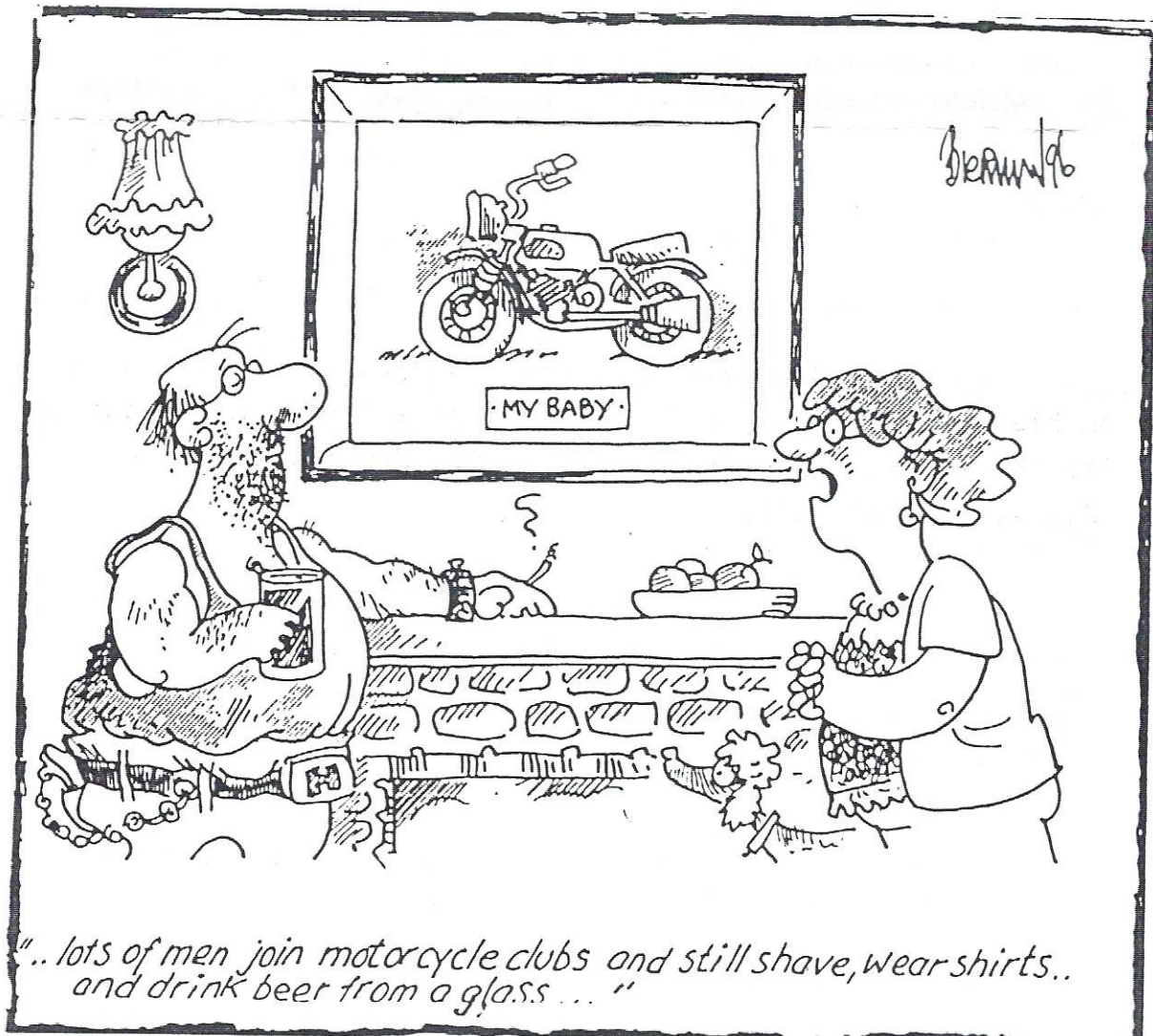
The meeting was held at the Pony Corral on Nairn.
