

Moratorium on Quebec Motorcycle Insurance Rate Increase

In Late January, the Societe de l'assurance automobile du Quebec (SAAQ) announced a oneyear moratorium on an increase in motorcycle insurance rates for 2000. Since May of last year, the MMIC (Motorcycle and Moped Industry Council) has been working hard to show that an increase was not justified based on safety statistics produced by the SAAQ, themselves. In mid December representatives of the MMIC, rider organizations and dealer groups met with officials of the SAAQ. After the meeting, the MMIC and rider groups had requested a one-year moratorium to study motorcycle rider safety and insurance claim's costs in detail. The MMIC welcomes the recent announcement and has agreed to continue to be part of the roundtable to discuss motorcycle safety and insurance rates.


