



### **MAAC Report- October Meeting**

#### General

In spite of the poor weather, this summer's events seem to have been reasonably successful. The MAAC meetings are on again after the summer layoff, and action is planned on a number of fronts. At this time MAAC is in good financial condition.

MAAC is establishing a scholarship fund for students at River East and Murdoch McKay Collegiates, for mechanic students.

Dues, insurance premiums, and event calendar dates are required soon.

I provided my E-mail address for easier mailings.

#### By-Laws

Efforts in combating restrictive derelict vehicle laws have produced some good results, and at present MAAC is helping a Municipality near Brandon write an acceptable by-law. As well, research is being done by a local law firm, to determine the feasibility of modifying existing bylaws.

#### **Vehicles**

On the vehicle front, a number of initiatives are being pursued, including a Collector vehicle plate (to exempt from emissions testing), multiple registration, Year of Manufacture plates, and changes to the MVB regulations as to bumpers and fenders.

My concern is that with all these items on the table, the beaureaucrats will merely keep stalling to avoid all that work. I suggested (as did others) that the list be pared down and some progress be made for a change.

#### NAAACCC

Wally Breer reported that efforts are being made to address concerns with pending Government regulations and the Kyoto Accord. These could include emission testing on a dyno under load. An exemption for 20 year old vehicles is being suggested.

I feel we should support these efforts. At \$1.50 per member per year, this is darn cheap insurance.

#### Comment

Unfortunately, a MAAC meeting is somewhat like the Chinese Water Torture, as the same things seem to be discussed repeatedly.

Should we stay with MAAC? Well, from an action standpoint, my feeling is –no. They seem to be preoccupied with being an "organization". From the cost of insurance – yes. We could not buy at that price elsewhere, and we do get credit for supporting the hobby – so I feel we should continue.

Should we join NAAACCC? - I think so - if they lose, we lose too.
