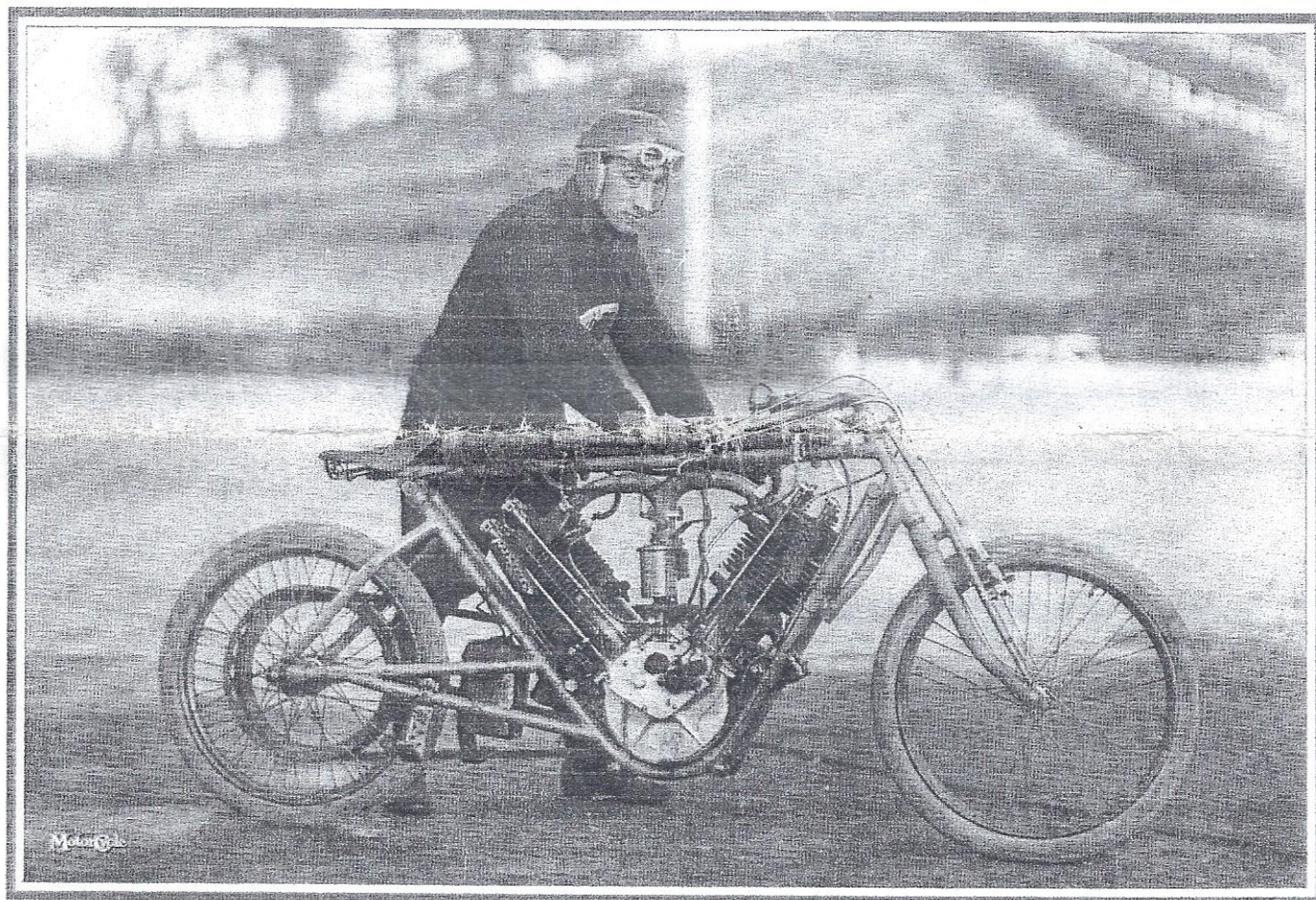

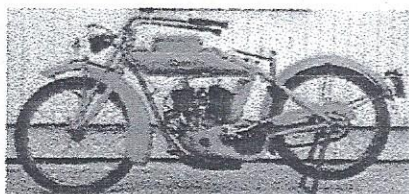

Our dues are paid for 2003, and insurance will have to be paid. Items for the event calendar booklet are due for January, and must be written on a recipe card.

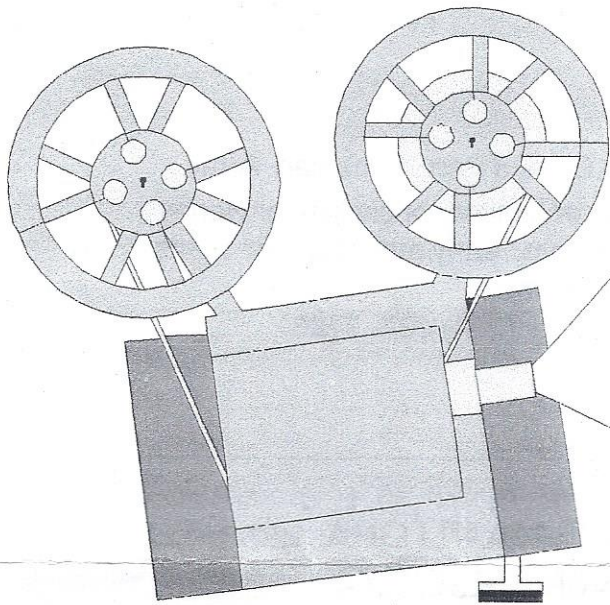
