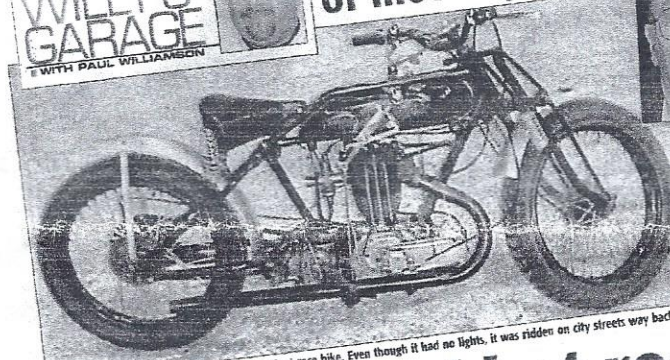

To help celebrate Harley Davidson's 100th anniversary, Lone Star Harley Davidson had a special display at the Cycle World Show last weekend at the Winnipeg Convention Centre.

The V-Rod is a bike fit for 100 years of Harley Davidson and was getting lots of attention.

The best way to describe this bad boy is as old as a muscle bike — low, fat and furious.

It features Harley's new Revolution 1300ci engine. The liquid-cooled, fuel-injected V-twin has a new fine-tuned 1300ci engine and produces a new-sound, 115-horsepower.

This race-inspired engine breathes through a

Founded in 1977 by Ross Menzies and Sigi Klamm, the club serves to keep the hobby of vintage motorcycle restoration and riding alive and well.

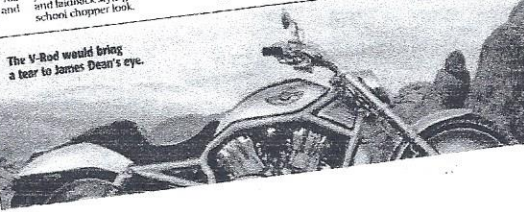
The makes and models club members ride make up a virtual who's who of two-wheeled history. The members are walking encyclopedias filled with interesting information about vintage bikes.
