an interesting assortment of ten machines decorated the parking lot.

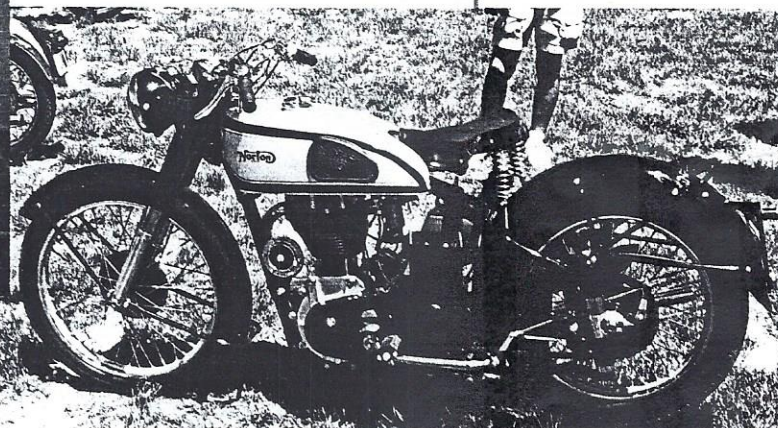
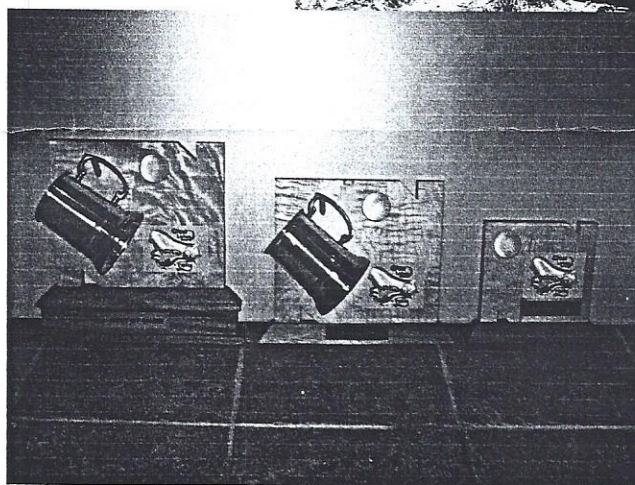
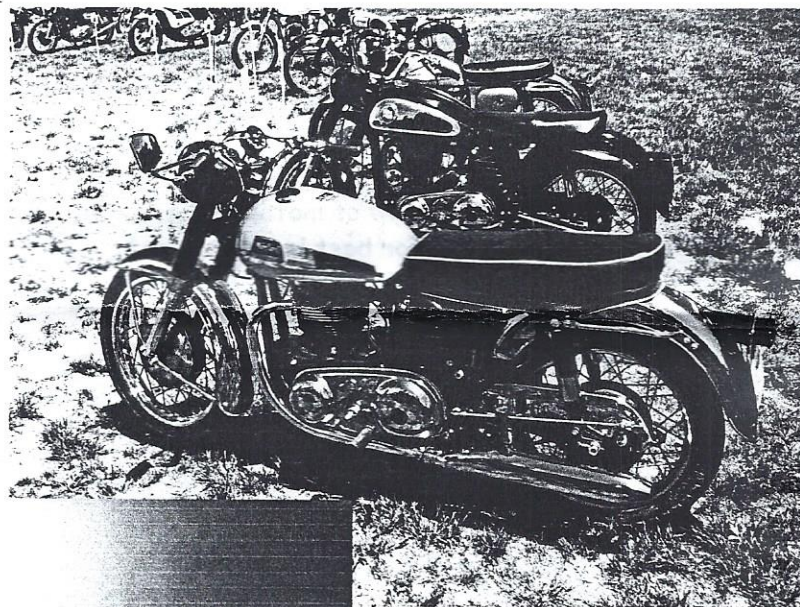
- in attendance were ten club members and two guests, Harvey Sawatzky and Richard Andrich.

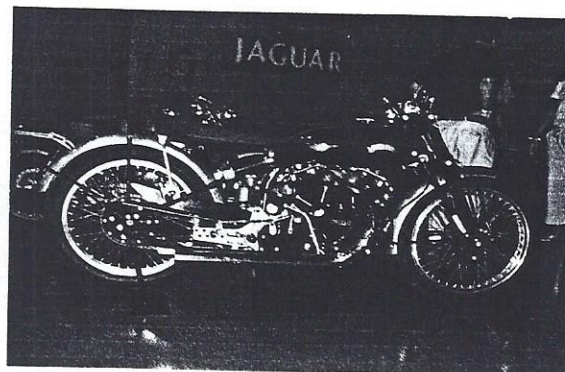
