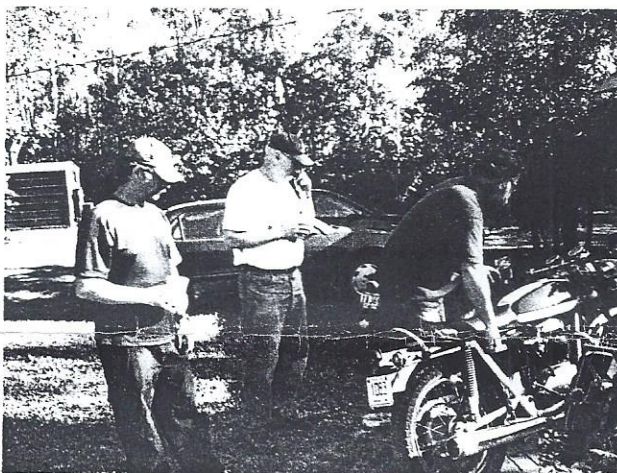

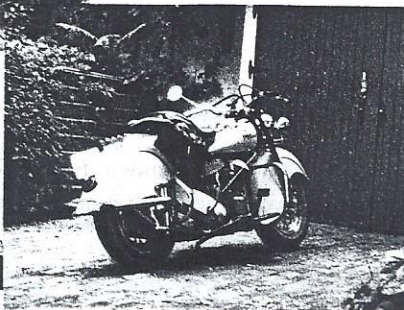

Minutes of September 26, 2006 Meeting at Woodhaven Community Club

- Attendance - 14 members, 3 executives and 1 motorcycle. President called meeting to order to 7:30 p.m.

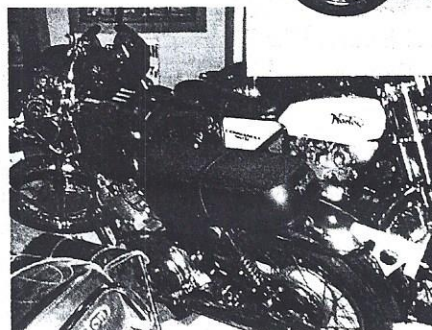
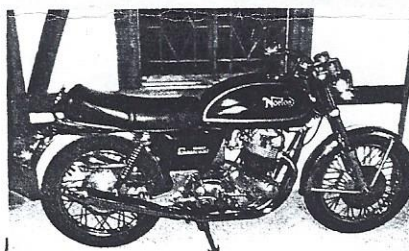
