This will be an opportunity to promote our July event (and sell T-shirts).

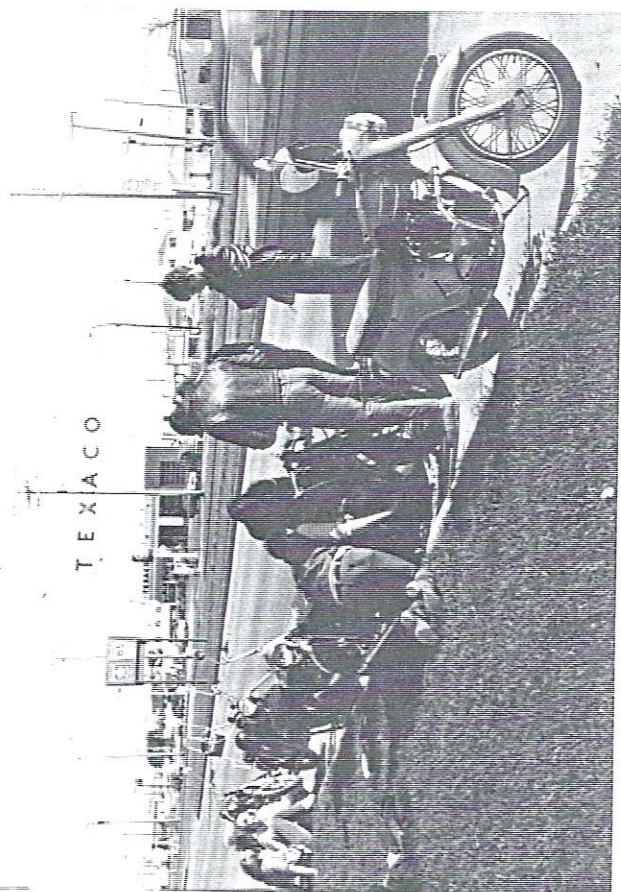

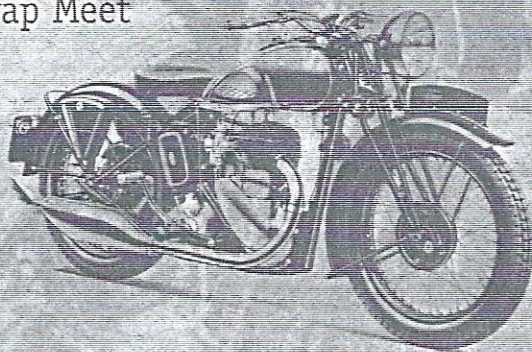
