



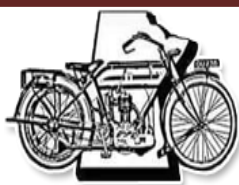

A Fundraiser for families impacted by Spina Bifida

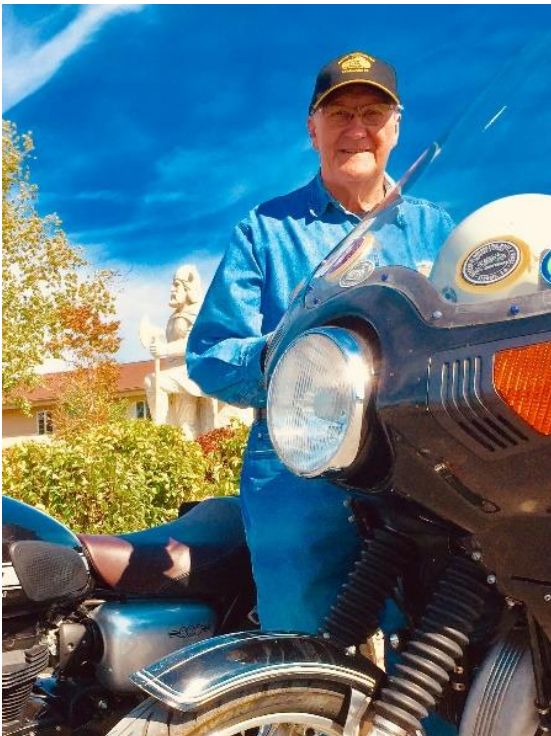

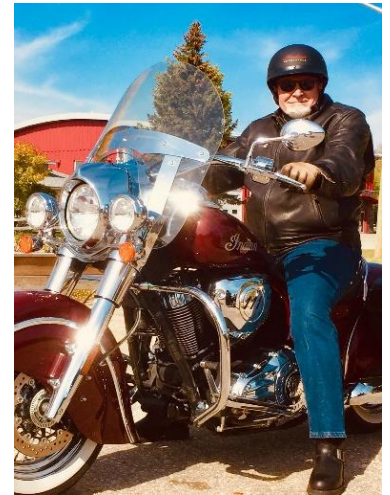
Money raised stays in Manitoba.

FRESH OUT OF GAS!

Soon after arriving in Canada having emigrated from South Africa, my wife and I had to re-do our Drivers Licences. All foreign drivers licences have to be re-done to Canadian standards, especially ours because like England, South Africa drive on the left. I had to do my motorcycle licence too even though I had been riding for nearly 50 years in South Africa.

I read in the handbook they gave me that I had to be able to ride the bike in a figure of eight, “to prove that I could handle the bike” they said. I was in my late sixties and knew that I wasn’t as strong anymore, and that my 1978 BMW R100S was a fairly heavy bike, especially when its big 24 litre gas tank was full. So I only put in enough gas for what I thought would easily complete the riding test.

I passed the written test easily and we set off on the riding test with the tester guy in a car driving behind me, and giving turning signal directions. All went well until we got to the busy Main Street when I ran out of gas and stalled, causing a bit of mayhem in the traffic! In my panic I didn’t think to reach down and turn the gas tap onto reserve!

The damage was done and I failed. I would then have to wait a mandatory two weeks and then make another appointment. My tester guy who was himself a biker said when I tried to explain, “We don’t require that figure-of-eight maneuver anymore, so I’ll give you a break. Put in sufficient gas and come back tomorrow!”

I did that and passed with flying colours!

On going to Morden’s Corn and Apple motorcycle Show and Shine later that year, the Christian Motorcyclists Association had a tent there and they were giving out bottles of cold water. Amongst the members in the tent was my Tester Guy wearing his Christian Motorcycle Club T shirt, and he spotted me. Turning to his mates he told the story about me running out of gas during his test, and pointing to me and shouting, “Have you got gas in your BMW?” All his friends killed themselves laughing at me!

A year later at the same Show and Shine, their tent was there again, he was there and exactly the same thing happened again! He didn’t shout this time but thoroughly enjoyed telling his friends the story!

I guess I deserved it for being so stupid!

Joe Sawtus 2021 Mileage Challenge

To participate you must be a member of the AMCM in good standing and listed in the 2021 AMCM Printed directory. New members that join to late to be included on the roster can take part next year.

At the start of your 2021 riding season record the odometer readings on the vintage motorcycles you intend to ride this year. Take a digital photo of your odometer, store as an email which could also include a picture of the motorcycle as well.

Prior to the October meeting record your odometer reading and calculate the miles ridden on your vintage bike(s) for the 2021 season. Each motorcycle gets a mileage boost which depends on its age.

1911-1940 6 x recorded miles
 1941-1950 4 x recorded miles
 1951-1960 3 x recorded miles
 1961-1970 2 x recorded miles
 1971-1980 1.5 x recorded miles
 1981-1991 1 x recorded miles

Example Don rides: 1965 Yamaha YM1 300 Miles X 2 = 600
 1974 Yamaha RD350 500 Miles X 1.5 = 750
 1985 Yamaha RZ500 800 Miles X 1 = 800 Don's Mileage total
 = 2150

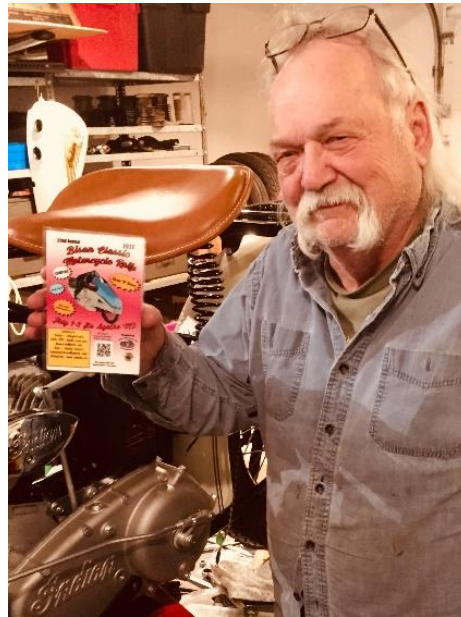
